TIP OVER HAZARD

Tipping of cabinet by a child or adult can result in serious injury or death. Follow all instructions for properly securing cabinet to avoid tipping. Children should never play with or around cabinet.



GUN STORAGE SAFETY

As a firearms owner, you are responsible for ensuring that guns in your home are kept inaccessible to children and other unauthorized persons. Firearms should be stored unloaded and locked in a cabinet, safe or storage case.

Gun locking devices, which render firearms inoperable, can be used in addition to locked storage. Always double-check firearms to confirm that they are unloaded when removing them from storage.

KEY STORAGE

Always keep keys in a secure location away from children. Keep a record of your key number in a secure location away from security cabinet as a reference for obtaining new keys.

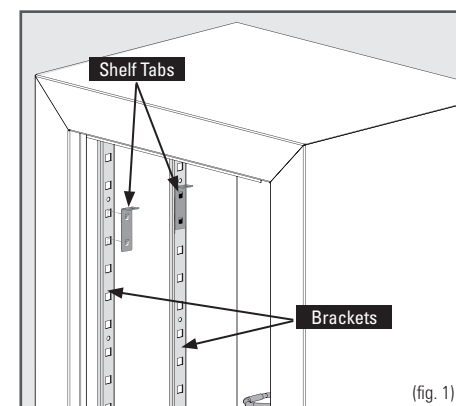
Set Up

1. Install Shelving

Place the four shelf tabs onto vertical brackets. (fig. 1)

Shelf can be placed toward the front or back of the cabinet to accommodate long guns in front or behind the shelf. (fig. 2)

Shelf can be bolted to tabs for added stability. (fig. 2)



2. Install Gun Racks

Place the tabs of the gun racks into the square holes on the vertical brackets. (fig. 3)

3. Flooring

Place the mat on inside floor of cabinet.

4. Secure Cabinet

To prevent theft and tipping, cabinet must be secured to wall studs and/or floor in a dry, secure area. Cabinet should be flat against wall studs and/or floor. (Hardware not included.)
